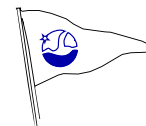

Rendezvous: At 17:00.

Start: Between yellow flag on RC boat and G"17" Fl G 4 sec channel marker off Concord Point Lighthouse, Havre de Grace (N 39° 32.167 W 076° 04.904). If code flag "L" is displayed, the starting line may be moved to a line between yellow flag on RC boat and another navigation aid or a temporary mark.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races)

Boats whose class's warning signal has not been made shall keep clear of the starting area. At the discretion of the race committee, the race may be delayed to await favorable winds

Course: Designated by letters and numbers displayed on the RC boat referencing HdGYC Standard Racing Marks (see http://www.hdgyc.org/course_map.html), government marks or special race buoy drop-marks. Letter "X" requires boats to cross through finish line (see below) as part of the set course.

Finish: Between yellow flag flown on Tidewater Marina flagpole ashore and HdGYC Standard Racing Mark "Z", unless course is shortened after the start at a designated mark of the course or at the intermediate crossing of "X".

Time Limit: 3 hours from the starting time for each class for all boats in a class. This changes RRS35.

Radio: Boats may monitor VHF channel 68 for communications from the Race Committee.

Protests: Postmarked on first business day after the race, sent to the entry address. Protest hearing time and place to be announced. No protests accepted the day of the event. This changes RRS61.3

Awards: 1st Place Overall Perpetual Trophy awarded to boat with best corrected time (Time on Distance) among all fleets, including right of first refusal to represent Upper Chesapeake Hospice at the National Hospice Regatta in 2011. 1st and 2nd in each class awarded, depending on participation. Awards presented at the post race party at Concord Point Lighthouse in Havre de Grace, MD on the evening of the race.

Social: Party at Concord Point Lighthouse, Havre de Grace, MD under cover following the race. All inclusive dinner and beverages available for sailors and crew at \$20/person with prior reservations. Live entertainment, silent auction and games will also be available for the benefit of Upper Chesapeake Hospice. Door prizes for skippers and crew. Launch service will be provided to anchored boats, pre and post party.
